

# Research Fellowship in Dermatology and Phlebology

## About the Fellowship

The **Dermatology and Phlebology Research Fellowship** program is an exciting and newly created opportunity funded by GALDERMA to attract outstanding medical graduates to start a career in dermatology. The program is established as a clinical or laboratory-based research fellowship for medical graduates with a special interest in dermatology and phlebology research and a dedicated commitment to dermatology as a medical specialty.

- Research fellowships are one year in duration based at **Dermatology, Phlebology and Fluid Mechanics Research Laboratory**, St. Vincent's Centre for Applied Medical Research (AMR), St. Vincent's Hospital, Sydney, NSW.
- Fellowships are offered preferentially to physicians with at least two years of post-graduate training and to those who wish to pursue further training in dermatology.
- This program will be facilitated on a platform of fully supported supervision and mentorship.
- Fellows will participate in the study design, implementation, presentation and publication of study results.
- Fellows will be encouraged to be involved in the clinical activities of the department of dermatology and will be invited to attend the clinical meetings.
